- 4. Shop for yourself
 - a. Go to SHOP ONLINE and use the marketplace to purchase products. Done Christmas shopping early and get money back for the band trip, win-win!
- 5. While going door to door is possible, students SHOULD NOT go alone. If the students choose to do so, please make sure that they are ALWAYS in a group and accompanied by one or more adults.
